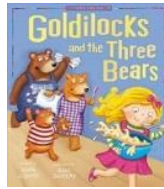

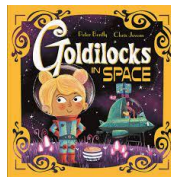

Maths

As Mathematicians, we will focus on developing a deeper understanding of numbers. We will consolidate counting objects using 1-1 correspondence and learn to represent numbers using mathematical graphics. We will also focus on sequencing using first, then and now and explore a range of simple repeating patterns.
