



<u>Literacy</u>

As Readers, we will continue to re-read simple sentences to develop our early fluency and understanding in literacy. In phonics we will begin Phase 4 of Little Wandle 'Letters and Sounds Revised'. As Writers, we will continue to focus on writing simple sentences in a variety of narrative and non-narrative forms and re-read what we have written.

<u>Maths</u>

As Mathematicians, we will continue to focus on developing our number knowledge through counting patterns for numbers beyond 10. We will also explore addition and subtraction and develop an understanding on sharing and grouping.

Communication and Language

As Attentive People, we will focus on learning to listen carefully to longer stories from the beginning to the end and respond to what we have heard. As Speakers, we will continue to focus on speaking clearly in full sentences, using sentence stems, and expressing ourselves in different ways.

People, we will focus on developing our art, design and technology, dance and singing skills through exploring and using a range of media and materials. As **Imaginative People**, we will begin to represent our own ideas through art and

As Good Citizens, we will be discussing our own and other people's feelings.
