



Year 2 Visit to Nell Bank on Monday 3rd March 2025

Dear Parents/Carers

This year we have booked a day visit to Nell Bank Outdoor Activity Centre in Ilkley for Year 2. Children would be expected to arrive at school via the small hall entrance at 8:30am, this is to ensure a prompt departure. We estimate to arrive back at school at 3:15pm, however as usual we will keep you updated through our text messaging system.

Our Visit to Nell Bank will focus around senses and adaptations. Using the natural environment children will develop their understanding of plants, animals and habitats. They will use each of their senses to explore the wide variety of habitats at Nell Bank and learn firsthand how animals use them to find food, water and shelter. Activities are dependent on weather however some activities during the day will include a Badger Sniff, Mole Walk, Mouse Maze, Rabbit Run, Habitat trail, Bond Dipping, Water and Adventure Play.

**Day Kit List:**

As the day consists mostly of fun outdoor practical activities, we kindly ask that all children come prepared for Winter weather. Your child will need the following items:

- Waterproof coat
- Scarf
- Gloves
- Hat
- Wellies

Other items of clothing will be provided by Nell Bank. Children will also need a packed lunch, including a filled drinks bottle. All the above must be in an appropriate bag such as a rucksack that the children can carry themselves. Please be aware that you do not send your child with items of food that contain nuts or fizzy drinks.

The cost of this visit will be £22.00 per child. The cost of the visit is calculated by dividing the total amount by the number of children in the class/year group. Any outstanding money resulting from non-payments is paid for by school. However, as the school has limited funds to fall back on, we rely on the good will of parents/ carers to ensure that the trip can visit can take place. Otherwise under some circumstances it may be necessary to cancel the visit. Payments must be made on **Parent Pay**, please note all payments are non-refundable. If you are entitled to Free School Meals with Benefits or have been entitled whilst at primary school, you may be able to access funding for this experience. Please come and talk to us.

Please make payments via Parent Pay and complete the permission slip by text form no later than 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025.
